  - Projects/programs should specifically address the reduction of precursor emissions, such as nitrogen oxides (NOx) and volatile organic compounds (VOCs), that contribute to ozone pollution in the summer months.
- Implementation of emerging technologies
  - Projects/programs should leverage emerging technologies to achieve measurable emissions reductions.
- Reduction of emissions in underserved areas
  - Projects/programs should target emissions reduction in at least one of the following:
    - Socioeconomically disadvantaged communities;
    - Areas of opportunity (geographic, industry, sector) that have not received adequate financial support.
