UCAIR Hosts Event to Help Improve Air Quality

In Partnership with Chevron, Rio Tinto Kennecott, and Davis Technical College

Kaysville, Utah — The UCAIR (Utah Clean Air Partnership) is encouraging residents to take a simple step toward cleaner air at its upcoming Gas Can Exchange on Saturday, May 30. Community members can bring in old, empty gas cans and swap them for a free, EPA-compliant replacement, available while supplies last.

The exchange is designed to cut down on volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions, which play a significant role in the formation of ground-level ozone, particularly during Utah’s warmer months. Older gas cans are prone to releasing fumes, while newer models are designed to prevent spills and reduce harmful emissions.

Location: Davis Technical College, 550 E 300 S, Kaysville, UT

Date: Saturday, May 30

Time: 8:00 a.m. – noon, or while supplies last

Offer: Free SureCan gas can in exchange for an older, empty gas can (limit two per household, while supplies last; carpooling is encouraged).
